

BREAKDANCE at Les Grands Ballets with NO LIMITS 2024:

A fusion of Olympic sport, artistic discipline, and inclusion



Montreal, January 31, 2024 - The National Centre for Dance Therapy of Les Grands Ballets Canadiens will take on a hip-hop ambiance on **February 9th and 10th as it hosts NO LIMITS 2024**, an international breakdance rendezvous. Over two evenings, B-Boys and B-Girls, amateurs and professional dancers from all backgrounds will challenge each other in dance battles. Dancers of all categories will celebrate inclusion within dance, a discipline long considered exclusive on multiple levels. In an electrifying atmosphere, the audience will witness performances by the incredible Luca Patuelli, also known as "Lazylegz," and his crew ILL-Abilities. Joining them will be numerous invited artists and athletes including world champion Phil Wizard, who will represent Canada at the Paris Olympic Games, as well as international dancers Bruce Almighty, Piecez, Girl Lynx, and Konatsu. These artists will challenge prejudices and push their own limits with power moves and improvisations.
